Thank you so much for your interest in the Adventure Playground and your generous donation! This program survives on people like you. And always remember, our place may look like a junkyard, but to the kids' who play here – it paradise!

What We NEED:

- Wood:
 - Quality Treated/Structure wood for building “bones” of wood structures.
 - General (untreated) wood for children’s use should be a minimum of 4’ in length. ¾”-1” thickness highly desired.
 - 12”x2”x8’+ landscape redwood (for sandbox).
 - Plywood (including full lengths for tables).
 - Large cardboard boxes.
- Saw Horses. Table Clamps.
- Medium Hand Clamps (for holding cardboard together).
- Items that can be dismantled or explored. Please check with staff as many electronic items (i.e TVs) have toxins that are difficult to dispose of).
- Outside Sink.
- Legos and other building toys.
- Buckets - all sizes from 3 to 50 gallons.
- Tree branches. Unless requested, minimum of 2” diameter, 4’ length. Branches must be pruned.
- Wheelbarrow.
- Car Tires – The bigger the better.
- Wheels, bicycles, gears, etc.
- Musical Instruments.
- Sewing machine, fabric and supplies.
- Dirt (no rocks please) and sand.
- Paint (latex only) and paintbrushes (1”-2” preferred.)
- Art and Copy Paper. Craft Items.
- Ropes (all kinds). Large climbable Cargo Nets.
- Zip Line.
- Hand Tools and Supplies (adult size only). Hammers, saws, hand drills, cordless drivers, bits, nails.
- Shovels and post hole digger.
- Circular, Table and Chop Saw (staff use only).
- Unique or uncommon building items for children (come-along, levels, etc).
- Car. To explore and play in.
- Tape – all kinds.
- Canvas and Canopies (no plastic tarps at this time).
- Couch and other “comfy” furniture.
- Refrigerator/Freezer. Blender. Hot Plate. Barbeque.
- Fire Pit. Firewood.
- Remote Controlled Cars
- “Unique” items that can be played with or transformed.
- Cosmetics/Make-Up (nail polish, etc).
- Chains – For building use.

What We Don't Need and Can't Use

- Oil-based paints.
- Wood items need to be acceptable for youth use. No “splintering” wood. Nails and other debris items need to be removed. No pallets.
- No small cardboard boxes unless specifically asked for.
- Recyclable/Household Items. Please call to discuss items. Unless specifically asked for we probably have plenty of recyclable items. Items are to be cleaned. No peanut product containers. No glass items.
- Please no cherished items. Most materials will be converted into another use by an imaginative child.

Items may be brought to the playground during regular operating hours or by special appointment. Please be aware that due to limited space we cannot take all items brought to us. Special arrangements can be made for significant donations. Please contact the Adventure Playground with any questions or to make a drop-of appointment.
