### Delivery

Items may be brought to the Playground during operating hours or by arrangements. Generally, no pick-up service is available.

Items in Constant Need (see notes below for types and restrictions):

- Wood)
- Paints.
- Paint Brushes
- Hot Glue Sticks (big and Small)
- Large Scissors
- Hot Glue Guns
- Duct Tape.
- Craft Items
- Pet Supplies. Chinchilla Food, Snacks & Bathing Ash. Fish Food and Long Term Fish Food.
- Cordless Drills. New only. Best are 12-14v.
- 2-Liter soda bottles (for rockets).
- Paper Cups (Medium and Small).
- Protein Bars (somewhat healthy).

### Standard Needs:

- Monetary donation for supplies to supplement donated items (i.e. galvanized screws for the wood structures) or staff support
- Wood.
  - Quality Treated/Structure wood for building "bones" of wood structures.
  - General (untreated) wood for children's use should be a minimum of 4' in length.  $\frac{3}{4}$ "-1" thickness highly desired. **STRONG NEED FOR 2x4s and 4x4s.**
  - 12"x2"x8'+ landscape redwood (for sandbox).
  - Plywood (including full lengths for tables). Minimum of 4sq. ft in size.
- Tools (usable, wood handles usually no good)
- Hardware – Nails, Screws, Misc.
- Dismantle-Explore Items (please check with staff as some electronic items contain toxins – no glass).
- Toys & Games (most will be repurposed, slightly broken often ok). Tonka Trucks & miniature cars (i.e. Hot Wheels-Match Box)
- Buckets (clean & able to hold water). All sizes..
- Tractor or Large Tires (no rims / exposed steel belts)
- Bicycles (somewhat rideable).
- Musical Instruments
- Fabrics and sewing supplies.
- Rocks, Sand (clean).
- Paint (latex only). Bright colors needed. Brushes. 1" and smaller. Minimum of  $\frac{1}{2}$  quart.
- Art and Copy Paper.
- Craft Items – **BIG NEED!**
- Ropes (all kinds).
- Large climbable Cargo Nets. Zip Line.
- Hand Tools and Supplies (adult size only). Hammers (fiberglass handles only), short saws, hand drills, cordless drivers, bits, nails.
- Unique or uncommon building items for children imagine or explore.
- Tape. All kinds. Duct, Masking, & Scotch.
- Canvas, Canopies, Large Umbrellas.
- Remote Controlled Cars
- Cosmetics (blush nail polish, etc.).
- Chains – All sizes.
- Modeling Clay.
- Clean recycle items (cans, plastic containers, etc.).
- Old Dryers. For "Wreck Center". No work – ok.
- Clean Storage Containers.  $\frac{1}{2}$  Gal. – 5 Gal.
- Decorative Items – Fake Flowers, Fort Decorations.

### Notes

- All donations must be viewed by staff before acceptance. We encourage you to send us a picture first. Items that are broken or not working are not always practical.
- No oil based paints.
- Wood items need to be acceptable for youth use. No "splintering" wood. Nails and other debris items need to be removed. No pallets. Actual wood or whole glued veneer sheets plywood only. No particle board, OSB, siding, MDF, or other types wood that are not suitable for outdoors or difficult to nail through.
- Cardboard. Large appliance sized boxes that can be used for "fort" making. Please no small boxes unless specifically asked for. Please remove all staples.
- Recyclable/Household Items (cleaned). No peanut product containers. No glass items.
- Please no cherished items. Most materials will be converted into another use by an imaginative child.
- No items with any glass or electronics, or other items with toxins (no TVs).
- No batteries of any sort.
