- Assist with set-up and tear down of daily operations and events.
- Maintain organization of supplies for programs and daily activities.
- Assist in recruiting and/or managing volunteers.
- Assist with outreach and other promotions.
- Monitor event activities.
- Handle problems that arise with guests.
- Assist or lead guest check-in/waiver-signing.
- Work closely with and supervise volunteers.
- Monitor activities and recommend modifications as needed.
- Clean and maintain safe play areas.
- Follow safety procedures; control and/or direct guests in crisis situations; prevent injuries or accidents.
